Head Teacher Remarks

The last time we were able to have any kind of awards ceremony was in June of 2019.

When we started session 2019-2020 we went into lockdown in March 2020 and did not return to school until August 2020.

Session 2020-2021 started very tentatively as increasing restrictions including face mask wearing, hand sanitising, social distancing, one-way systems, eating outdoors, open windows etc were all introduced.

Then we went into lockdown in January 2021 and did not return to school until April 2021. April 2021 to the end of session was a particularly stressful term as teachers and senior pupils were all tasked with producing evidence of attainment in what was termed the 'alternative assessment model'.

This session, 2021-2022, also started tentatively as we were very unsure how long we were going to be able to sustain being in school or whether new strains of Covid would result in further lockdown. At times we had to battle through high numbers of pupil and high numbers of staff absence, having contracted Covid-19. As vaccines started to be pushed into arms, building up a level of immunity, a measured confidence started to return.

April 2022 saw the biggest change in restrictions in general public life, however, schools were advised to maintain a cautious minimalist approach to all school activities where young people and adults are close together in a confined space. As this session draws to a close, once more, at CDHS, we have experienced high staff and pupil absence due to covid-19. We hope all those currently infected have a speedy return to good health so that they can enjoy their holidays.

I hope all of our young people began to feel a difference in school this summer term from the last two and a half sessions. Many of the school activities that add to the whole experience of coming to school have started to happen again bringing a great deal more life to our school.

Here we are now making a cautious minimalist start on an awards event.

It is almost as if we are beginning to return to some level of normality.

Long may it continue!

So without further ado lets present some awards to young people who have achieved great things in their classes and who have demonstrated through their efforts, resilience and self-belief a determination to succeed.
