## **New Award for 2023**

Mrs Janette Montague is currently a resident of Troon in Ayrshire. She contacted the school in the middle of May 2023 to enquire if she could sponsor a prize in memory of her brother. She and her brothers attended Castle Douglas High School in the 1960s and early 1970s. Ms Montague's brother, Walter John Scott, after some time at technical college in Dumfries, enrolled to do Voluntary Service Overseas, and was posted to Indonesia. He worked on the Island of Sumbawa, assisting with a water project. In February 1981 he moved to the island of Jakarta, and spent a couple of months there learning something of the culture and language. Later making his way through Bali to catch a morning ferry to the island of Lombok, he hit a pot hole on the road and was thrown from his motorbike and died in hospital in Denpasar, Bali, on May 14th 1981 aged 24. Mrs Montague comments that Walter wasn't an academic, but was technically minded, loved the outdoors and hillwalking, and was a keen folk musician.

After some discussion Mrs Montague decided that she would like to have a junior school award in memory of her brother. The trophy that Mrs Montague has provided as a fitting tribute to her brother is an Indonesian Singing Bowl.

The Walter John Scott Memorial Trophy is presented to a pupil who has persevered and overcome difficulties, to succeed, in any subject. The first recipient of this new award who has faced difficulties and is making great progress in overcoming them, especially in her grasp of English and French is:
